Call for paper

We are pleased to announce the Paper Development Interdisciplinary Workshop at the crossroad between organisation studies, entrepreneurship and supply chain management.

The workshop is organised by the WAVE Lab and the Department of Management, Information and Production Engineering of the University of Bergamo. The workshop is an opportunity for advanced PhD students and early career scholars to discuss current research projects, develop new research ideas, and build networks with international peers and leading scholars.

Workshop Format

The workshop will include:

- › **Keynote speeches:** three keynote speeches from leading scholars in management about (i) Idea Generation, (ii) Theory Building and Development and (iii) Action Research and Qualitative Methods;
- › **Roundtable discussions:** participants will present and discuss ongoing research projects to receive feedback from peers and senior scholars. Different roundtables will be organised to discuss separately the research idea, theoretical foundation or methodology;
- › **Social events:** we believe the best ideas are born at coffee and dinner tables. We will give space to social moments to let participants network and exchange ideas in an informal and relaxed environment.

Target group and eligibility

Eligible candidates are PhD students and early career scholars with an interest in management. The workshop is open to a broad range of theoretical perspectives and methodological approaches, with a specific focus on qualitative research designs.

To apply, please send an E-Mail with a CV and an extended abstract to wavelab@unibg.it by **June 15th, 2024**. The extended abstract (max. 1.000 words, including references) should summarize a current or planned research project (including research idea, theory, method, and current status). The participants should indicate their preference for the roundtable discussion on research idea, theoretical foundation or methodology. Participants will be notified about the acceptance to the workshop by **June 20th**. Participants should send a 3 (minimum) to 5 pages (maximum) extended abstract of their research to be circulated for the roundtable discussions by **June 30th**.

Participation cost

The participation to the workshop is free and includes a free lunch and dinner. Participants will be responsible for their travel arrangements and accommodation.

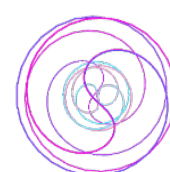
